Watch-it cloud user manual

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This user manual will give you a comprehensive tour of the Watch-it cloud features. Our most recent product offers a collection of characteristics that allow enhanced remote monitoring for your location: a general overview of all locations, watching instant footage that is taken live, right from that specific moment in time as well as historic informations such as video alerts.

Watch-it cloud is compatilble with the desktop version of Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge and Apple Safari. For remote management of the sites from a mobile device use Watch-it mobile.

1.1 Main sections

This quick access menu allows you to change basic settings of the application

- Username: it displays the user that is currently logged into the application
- Language: you can change the display language of the application from the list of available languages (currently available languages are English, Dutch and German, with support for more languages coming in the future)
- Theme: change between light theme (which is the default theme when you first log in) or dark theme

Language and theme settings are synced to the user account and will be remembered if you log in from a different device.



When accessing Watch-it cloud you will be redirected to Watch-it Identity Service webpage. Enter your username and password credentials in the input fields and then click on the 'Login' button.

2.1 Setting up multi-factor Authentication

Multi-factor authentication is a way of confirming your identity when you try to sign it to Watch-it cloud.

If multi-factor authentication was requested for you user account, after a successful login using the username and password provided by BigBrother, you will be automatically redirected to a new page where you will be asked to enroll a mobile device.

- 1. Install one of the following applications available on both App Store and Play Store:
 - Google Authenticator
 - Microsoft Authenticator
 - FreeOTP
- 2. Open the application and scan the QR code on the screen. Watch-it Identity Service will be added to your account
- 3. Enter the 6 digit one-time code into Watch-it cloud

NOTE: If you are using Microsoft Authenticator or FreeOTP, you will need to tap on Watch-it cloud services to get the one-time code.

- 4. Enter a the device name. It is recomended to use an easy to recognize device name in the case that you will be using multiple devices to authenticate from.
- OPTIONAL: If you want to sign out from other devices where you were previously signed in make sure the "Sign out from other devices" option is checked.
- 6. Click "Submit".

You will be signed in and redirected to Watch-it cloud. If you are not able to proceed make sure that the one-time code has not expired during the enrollment process.


2.2 Incorrect credentials

If the credentials are not found or incorrect and the login is not successful, the username and password fields are underlined with a red line.

3 Network

Logging into Watch-it cloud for the first will open on the 'Network' tab displaying a map or list with pins to indicate the status of your locations. This status depends on the level of integration and purchased optional functionality per site, as well as the user-specific settings of pin colours. See 'Settings' for more details.



The color of the pins by default indicate the following:

The location is in good shape, there are no problems

The location cannot be access through Watch-it cloud

There are problems on the location or active warnings.

The location could not be reached in the last hour or has critical alerts

The color reflections of the pins can be changed in the settings.

If multiple locations are in the same general area those will be grouped until the map is zoomed in or the group is clicked on, in which case the map will zoom in to a close view. The color of the group indicates the same as mentioned above, prioritizing higher severity.

When a location is currently selected and the details pane is open, the pin will be highlighted on the map.

3.1 Searching for locations

If you have multiple locations under management there are multiple ways to search for one or multiple specific locations:

- Select the desired locations from the menu on the left side of the screen.
- Use the locations filter: on the side menu type in the name of the location that you are searching for and press 'Enter'.
- Use the map zoom in to a location and click on its pin/

If you used a filter to find a location, the map will zoom in and update the pins accordingly to show only the locations selected.

Whether you want to see detailed information about the status of the location, control various devices, or access the recorder remotely, click on the pin of a location and menu will open up on the right side of the screen

Remote access to recorders through ways other than "SecureConnect" use Citrix and as such, users will need to have Citrix Workspace App installed on their device to use those features.

3.3.1 Live Cameras

Live camera playback is only available on recorders running the latest version of Watch-it core. Locations using older versions of Watch-it will refresh with a still image every 5 seconds.

To open the live page of the location on Watch-it cloud, click the ² button in the Location details pane. For live camera feed make sure that Live toggle is turned on.

Steps to successfully watch the live video footage:

- 1. Select the cameras video layout (1 / 4 / 9 / 8 / 11 / 16 screens on the layout).
- 2. Drag and drop the camera from the list displayed on the left side bar in the desired layout.
- 3. Repeat until you have managed to identify the needed footage.
- 4. Enable/disable the camera name whenever needed.

5. If the selected camera is a dome, use the controls from the bottom-right corner to manually move it to the desired angle (left/right/top/bottom/center) or by using the arrows on the keyboard or zoom in/out (+/-).

Save a new layout

Click on the 'Add' link to define a new layout. A popup will open and you can fill in the field with a preferred name and then click on the 'Save' button.



The saved layout is consisted of a collection of preferred cameras that you can watch whenever you need to investigate more thoroughly a certain event. The aim of this feature is to save the time invested in looking for the right combination of cameras that emphasizes the event over and over again. For example, you can select:

- all the cameras that are related to carwash
- all the cameras that target a specific pump
- all the cameras that watch the garbage bins


Live controls allows the user to control the output of the I/O box modules on site, see in real time the status of the location and take control of dome cameras



If enabled from System Settings, some site controls will show a prompt to confirm the action, elimination accidental activation of the I/O box output.


3.3.2 System Status

The "System status" section in the details pane of a location represents the status of the recorders, cameras and connected devices present on site.



- The recorder and atteched devices are in good working condition
- The location is not connected to Watch-it cloud. In case of cameras or devices: no information could be retrieved from the location.
 - Guard-it reported that there are problems on the location (e.g. one or more cameras not working) or a recorder could not be reached in the last 2 hours.
- The recorder could not be reached for more than 2 hours or all cameras are not recording.

Clicking the "View details" button under one of the recorders will show the current Guard-it status in a new window.

3.4 SecureConnect


SecureConnect is a technology developed by BigBrother, designed to replace Citrix for connecting to your locations conveniently through Watch-it cloud directly from your web browser.

Please note that SecureConnect is compatible only with recorders running Watch-it core version 5.0 or later. If you need to access recorders running older versions of Watch-it, you will need to have Citrix installed on your local machine.

To establish a connection to any available location, begin by logging in to Watch-it cloud. Next, select the desired location in the Network page. In the location details panel, you will find the "SecureConnect" button. Click on it and choose the recorder from the provided list. If a recorder is unavailable, the button will appear greyed out.



The selected location will automatically open in a new tab.



When using SecureConnect for the first time, you need to allow the Watch-it cloud website to open new tabs. In your browser, select the option to always allow pop-ups from Watch-it cloud, then click "Done" to confirm.



If Watch-it core doesn't open automatically in a new tab or if your browser isn't set up to allow new tabs from Watch-it cloud, follow these steps: Click the "Copy URL" button, open a new tab in your browser, and paste the link of the recorder into the address bar.

To exit, simply close the tab in which Watch-it core is open.

You can open a maximum of 3 locations in a 5 minute time. If you want to open a forth locations you will be prompted to close the connection to any of the 3 previously opened locations.

To close a connection, click on the close icon \times located to the right of the location's name. If you wish to close all connections simultaneously, click the "Close all" button at the bottom of the pop-up window.

Please note that connections to the recorders will automatically close after five minutes of closing the tab.



4 Cameras

The cameras sections allow you to see a static image from all of the location in a collective way. The cameras shown are not a live video feed, as default the images shown are from the moment you access the page. You can change the time and day of the shown images in the side menu.



In case you've filtered a location in the Network page previously, when you access the Cameras section the same filters will be applied. The filter here allows you to filter on camera names. To change your locations, click 'Active locations' on top and change the selected locations.

To have a closer look at one of the camera, click on the desired camera and it will open up in full screen view. Further functionalities include downloading a single picture (.JPEG) or a report of pictures (.PDF).



To return to the cameras overview and close the camera view that is in full screen either click on button in the top right of the screen or the background.

4.1 Export images

In the Cameras section you have the ability to save the images onto your device.

The saved snapshots are named automatically using the camera name

There are multiple ways to export image(s):

- To export a singular image click on the download icon available at any of the cameras and it will automatically download the snapshot of the camera. Alternatively if you have a camera opened in full screen view in the bottom right of the camera you have the option to save the image currently open
- To export multiple images at the same time click on the download button in the sidebar (see section 3.2), select the cameras you want to save the images from on the main page and click download. Exporting multiple images will save those images in a PDF report. This process can take longer depending on the number of cameras selected.

The alerts are sorted newest from top, and the severity of the alert is represented by the color of the alert icon as follows:



Multiple alerts from the same type will be grouped together to have a better overview on multiple locations at the same time. To display grouped alerts click on the dropdown arrow available on the left side of a given alert. The dropdown list will show alerts of the same type (e.g. location, alarm code, category). To close the group simply click the dropdown icon again.

The order of the columns are customizable by clicking the gear icon in the top left of the table. Drag and drop the columns to their desired order. After customizing save the layout by clicking the save icon in the top left of the table.

5.1 Detailed view

The detailed view allows you to oversee current or historical events on locations and make critical decisions in case of emergency. To see detailed information about the alert click on a specific alert to open the detailed view pane.

Besides the general information already available in the general table view of the Alerts section, the detailed view also show the camera linked to the event, the ability to change the camera for a better perspective and historical data about the same event (e.g. when did it trigger in the past)

5.2 Export


Each alert can be individually exported by opening an alert into detailed view and selecting one of the export options from the bottom right of the pane. There are four ways for you to export and share alerts:

- **Print:** this option automatically downloads the alert(s) on the recorder on location and print it using a printer connected to the recorder
- Mail: it will open a prompt asking for the recipient and a message. In case you need to send the alert(s) to multiple people, click the 'Add email address' and fill in with the required information.
- Secure Link: it will create a link that can be sent and used to open the report. The recipients of the secure link need the have access to Watch-it cloud to be able to open it.
- **Download**: it directly downloads the report the computer the application is opened on and allows you the share the report by any preferred means.

Multiple alerts can only be downloaded by clicking the export button in the side menu. Select the alerts that you want to download and click 'Download'. The application will prompt you to select the type of file you want to download: PDF or CSV. It is important to note that only PDF files will contain the image of the alert.



To access the Settings menu open the user menu by clicking on the icon in the top right of the page and select the Settings option
